

In order to encourage the distribution of scholarly work for educational purposes while also retaining authors' and the publisher's rights and interests, Exercise Fitness & Health Alliance (EFHA), details below its guidelines for fair use and permissions request policy. Articles published in the Journal of Exercise Fitness & Health Alliance, an official publication of EFHA (including electronic resources) may be copied or reused without permission; for questions or requests relating to both non-commercial and commercial uses of material appearing in EFHA publications, please refer to the guidelines below.

### **Journals**

EFHA is currently publishing only one Journal titled "*Journal of Exercise Science and Physiotherapy*" short name JESP bearing ISSN no 0973-2020 link <http://www.efha.in/> . Please note that having a subscription to a print or electronic version of EFHA's journals does not grant one the right to reuse published articles without consulting the guidelines below or contacting EFHA. Permissions for most reuses of articles in EFHA's journals needs to be obtained from EFHA.

### **Authors**

- Authors of articles published in JESP, EFHA's journal are allowed to use their articles for their own teaching and scholarly work without seeking permission.

### **Educational Usage**

- Permission to copy articles for use in the classroom, either distributed directly to students or incorporated into a course pack, should be obtained from EFHA. Some fees may be associated for permissions being sought.
- If a scholar wishes to use a portion of an article appearing in one of EFHA's journals in a new work, he/she may do so without requesting permission as long as the material reproduced does not exceed 1,000 total words or 300 consecutive words from the published source and is properly cited. In addition, the material reused should not make up more than 10% of the new work and the material reused should not exceed more than 10% of the entirety of the published source. ### **Institutional Repositories**

- Authors of articles published in EFHA's journals are allowed to archive a **PDF** of their final published articles in their institution's repository. Authors should instruct that the repository acknowledge **EFHA** when archiving articles published in EFHA's journal with a formal/traditional bibliographical citation.
- Authors are **not** granted permission to archive "pre-prints" of their articles (i.e., an article accepted but not yet published) in their institution's repository.

### **Publishers**

- Publishers who wish to reuse articles, figures, graphics, tables, or other material appearing in EFHA's journals should contact EFHA at [efha2014@gmail.com](mailto:efha2014@gmail.com). and provide the journal name, volume, issue number, article title, and page numbers for the material being requested, and how it will be used in the new work. Some fees may be associated for permissions being sought.
